




CLASS SIZE






ON-TIME GRADUATION


FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

The goals for the Cascade Opportunity Ctr are designed to support the whole student by addressing academic and social/emotional needs. Curriculum is designed to address individual coursework required for students in order to graduate on time. Staff support student learning needs by building positive relationships first. High academic and behavioral expectations that promote a culture of acceptance and support is the standard for our school. Regular communication between home and school will be provided to inform about student progress and behavior. Procedures to maximize student attendance and participation are implemented.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

At the Cascade Opportunity Center will work to provide work to build relationships between staff, students and families through positive behavioral supports and check ins. Staff are given training opportunities about implementation of trauma sensitive practices and other strategies for students' social/emotional development. Other supports include the Safe Oregon Reporting Hotline and Trillium Counseling services for qualified students. Staff regularly teach and practice school safety routines and emergency procedures throughout the school year. Staff proactively address bullying and harassment.







ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Advanced coursework is available to all students though our online educational curriculum. AP courses offered include: English, Math, Science and Social Studies. Dual enrolled students may access AP classes at Cascade High School and classes offered through Chemeketa Community College.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Our online courses here offer a variety of Career and Technical Ed. classes which include: Business Marketing, Health Sciences and Computer Applications. Dual enrolled students can access a variety of CTE classes at Cascade High School. Cascade O.C. also provides support for completing job applications, job shadowing and visits to college campuses.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Cascade Opportunity Centers offers beginning of the year Meet and Greet with individual students and families. Parents and staff hold regular check in meetings throughout each Trimester and families receive weekly progress reports via the online curriculum. Communication between school and families are conducted through meetings, phone, emails and through the school website. English language supports for students and families are provided when English is not the primary language spoken.
